- Crystal Springs Rodeo Security are Law Enforcement trained and Deputized by the Deuel County Sheriff
- Security have the authority to make arrests for any violation of South Dakota Law and to enforce the Ranch Regulations
- EMTs have Emergency Medical Training and should be contacted for any medical conditions

CRYSTAL SPRINGS RODEO COMMITTEE

Crystal Springs Rodeo, Inc. committee members ("Committee") have authority to evict campers not following the Regulations

CRYSTAL SPRINGS RANCH REGULATIONS

Unless approved by the Committee in writing all individuals shall abide by these regulations

GENERAL:

- 1) Any person 6 years and older must purchase a campground pass which includes a wristband and a ticket prior to entering the rodeo campground. If you lose it, you must buy a new pass.
- 2) **You must wear your wristband and keep your ticket stub(s) in your possession while in the campground.** You may be asked to show your ticket and wristband at any time by Committee or Security.
- 3) **ALL vehicles entering the rodeo campground must have a vehicle campground pass and are subject to search at all times.**
- 4) **Have photo identification with you at all times.** Security is authorized to remove persons from the campground consuming alcohol that cannot produce legal age identification
- 5) No driving of vehicles after dark except to leave or return to the Campsite.
- 6) **Speed Limit is 10 MPH on the ranch. Do not exceed 10 MPH . ALWAYS YIELD to PEDESTRIANS and HORSES!**
- 7) No horseback riding after dark.
- 8) All passengers shall ride inside the vehicle. No individuals shall ride in the open back of a vehicle, trailer or pickup box.
- 9) No ATVs, Dirt Bikes, Motor Scooters, Go Carts or similar vehicles are allowed, unless approved by the Committee.
- 10) No driving through low muddy areas, steep side hills and ravines. No driver shall spin tires in the mud or drive in a careless manner. Vehicles that are stuck, shall use a professional towing service. Vehicles with a loud exhaust or spinning tires may be parked by Security or Rodeo Committee or removed from the Ranch.
- 11) **No glass** alcohol, beer or pop bottles are allowed outside a camper or tent.
- 12) No fireworks allowed after midnight. Be responsible. Do not shoot or use fireworks in a manner to scare horses, livestock and other campers.
- 13) Horses must be secure. Only portable corrals or fence panels are allowed as pens. **No hobbles or ground spikes.**

CAMPSITES:

- 1) No camping in the area designated at EVENT PARKING.
- 2) No camping within 25 feet of the main graveled roads.
- 3) **At midnight,** you must turn down the volume on your music and lower voices, showing respect to other campers.
- 4) Campfires must be contained, controlled, and no larger than 3 foot in diameter. Fires deemed too large by rodeo security will be extinguished.
- 5) No digging of fire pits.
- 6) Do not burn waste, plastic, cans, glass, furniture, etc. in your campfire.
- 7) Absolutely no burning upholstered couches, chairs or other household furniture. These items are not allowed on the rodeo grounds. Only camping and patio furniture is allowed.
- 8) **Clean up your Campsite every day. Dumpsters and Garbage cans are provided. Use them. Penalties may be imposed!**
- 9) Each encircled compound of campers must include adequate space for a full size emergency response vehicle to access the interior area of your compound. Do not completely enclose your compound.
- 10) Be considerate of the size of your campsite. Do not claim more area than necessary and limit the size of your site to accommodate others.
- 11) No campers or campsites may be set up against a fence. At all times you must give enough space between the fence and your campsite for security and emergency vehicles to travel.
- 12) No temporary fences of any kind are allowed to establish a boundary to your campsite or compound.

SOUTH DAKOTA LAWS

Abide by all South Dakota Laws including, but not limited to the following:

- * It is illegal for a person under 21 to possess or drink alcoholic beverages.
- * It is illegal for a person to provide a minor with any alcoholic beverages.
- * It is illegal to be in physical control of a vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- * It is illegal to have an open container, an alcoholic beverage, in a vehicle.

*Rodeo Security is responsible for ALL South Dakota laws and may make arrests accordingly.

VEHICLE SEARCH: All vehicles and personal property are subject to search upon entry, and at all times while on the Crystal Springs Ranch; if you do not consent to a search, then you may be asked to leave the Ranch immediately with no refund.

ARENA RULES:

- 1) No pets allowed within 100 yards of the rodeo arena or parking area. Never leave animals unsecured at your campsite or in the back of your vehicle.
- 2) **No seat reservations (including tarps, stakes, ropes, etc.) are allowed in the arena.** Tarps can only be placed once the gates are open at 6:00pm and must be removed at the end of the performance. Tarps must be occupied after placement. Tarps placed prior to the performance, unoccupied tarps, or tarps remaining after the performance will be removed by the Rodeo Committee.
- 3) **Have photo identification with you at all times.** Security is authorized to remove persons from the arena who are consuming alcohol and cannot produce legal age identification
- 4) **Have an "age verified" wristband** to consume beer in the arena.
- 5) Bags/Backpacks/Coolers Coolers and bags of any size **with hard sides** are NOT allowed in the Crystal Springs Rodeo arena. Crystal Springs Rodeo, Inc. reserves the right to inspect and remove any package or container or their contents.
- 6) **Sealed, bottled water 32 oz. or less, soft sided single juice or milk containers** for children, and liquids required for legitimate medical purposes are the only outside beverages permitted into the Crystal Springs Rodeo arena.
 - a. Beer, liquor, wine, flavored water, performance beverages (Gatorade, Powerade, etc.), and pop are NOT permitted into the arena.
- 7) The Crystal Springs Rodeo permits rodeo fans to bring **food** into the rodeo arena.
- 8) For the general safety of all rodeo fans, the following items are not allowed into the arena: dogs, fireworks, flasks, guns or weapons of any kind.

If I or my group do not follow the Regulations and Law I understand that I may be **evicted** from the ranch without a refund, be fined, arrested, subject to civil or criminal proceedings, and/or permanently banned. I understand my vehicle and personal property is subject to search at all times. I also understand that I am responsible for all items of personal property and I must secure these items. *
